Each week the Farmington Hills Parks and Recreation Department presents a synopsis of upcoming activities in this column. For further information regarding programs, call the parks and recreation department at 474-6115.

GERALD FORD MUSEUM, GRAND RAPIDS TOUR — Join us on Tuesday, June 8, for a trip to Grand Rapids. While there we will enjoy the Gerald Ford Museum, the Amway Grand Plaza Hotel and if time permits, various other points of interest. Departure from Farmington Hills City Hall is 8:30 a.m. by deluxe motor coach and will plan to return to Farmington Hills at approximately 5:30 p.m. Fee is \$16.50, which includes round-trip transportation and museum entrance fees. Lunch is on your own.

SPRING #LING — The annual spring senior adult dinner dance will be held at the Gathering Place on Friday. The center will open at 6 p.m. for social enjoyment with dinner being served at 7 p.m. After dinner the Farmington senior adult band will begin, playing music to dance by. Cost is \$8 per person, you must pre-register.

GOLF LESSONS — The first session of golf lessons are about to get underway. Learn the basic fundamentals or improve your established skills. Classes will be held on Tuesday and Thursday, are 50 minutes in length and will be held twice each week for four weeks. Each participant will be asked to purchase a bucket of balls for each lesson. Classes will be held at Sliger Golf Range on Grand River, west of Haggerty Road. Classes will be held in the morning and early evening. The class fee is \$18 per participant. Hurry and register, each class is limited to eight participants.

SAFETY TOWN — Safety Town is an educational setting by which safety lessons are taught with the child learning through actual participation and demonstrations. Instructions include pedestrian, motorist, bus, stranger, police, fire, railroad crossing, bicycle, drug and general play and home safety. Farmington Hills Safety Town is a 10-hour course (two hours a day, five days per week for two weeks) designed especially for children entering kindergarten this fall. All other 4-, 5- and 6-year-olds will also be accepted. The program site is the Shiawassee Recreation Center and the sessions begin in late June and continue through mid-August. Fee is \$27 per child. This includes a T-shirt and graduation certificate. Register early, space is limited.

FOOD CO-OP — The senior adult food co-op continues to be a great success. The bi-monthly program offers a great variety of vegetables which adds up to a substantial savings. The initial membership fee is \$1 and the cost of the bi-monthly food bag is \$3. We ask that members help out periodically if they are able. To join the food co-op, one can register at the senior adult center located in the Mercy Conference Center on 11 Mile just east of Middlebelt Road.

ADAPTIVE RECREATION COFFEE HOUSE — In celebration of Memorial Day, the theme of the coffee house scheduled for Friday will be "Good Ole U.S.A." The activity is designed for mild to moderately mentally and/or physically impaired individuals 14 years of age and up. The program will begin at 7 p.m. and last to 9 p.m. and will take place at the Shiawassee Recreation Center, 30415 Shiawassee Road. The fee is 50 cents at the door.

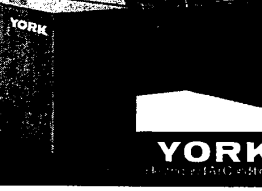
