# Robotics discussed

James Dillon, director of manufacturing technology applications at Ford Motor Co., will discuss the importance of robotics today and in the future at the Auburn Hills Campus of Oakland Community College on June 2. The lecture, sponsored by the International Students Organization, will begin at 7 p.m. in F-Building. Admission is free.

Dillon, who joined Ford in 1951, is an expert in production technology and numerical control. For the past seven years, he has been operations manager of all Ford stamping plants, chassis plants, and most recently, transmission plants.

Dillon also has been a member of a United Nations team of seven to assist

Israel in developing its metal working technology and has served in Vienna as a U.S. representative on a council organized by the UN to study the establishment of metal working industries in 30 developing nations.

He has also assisted the UN Industrial Development Organization establishing a numerical control center in Bangalore, India, and has worked on manufacturing design programs for four Hong Kong companies. In June, Dillon will serve as consultant to the South Korean government on automotive manufacturing.
