Interior design project judged

Michelle DeMartini, a Michigan State University senior from Farmington, was one of 10 interior design students at MSU whose class project rug design was critiqued by a major custom rug firm in Chicago.

Some 40 students in a human environment and design class last winter participated in the project of designing a 9 by 15 area rug to complement any

object or piece of material in the same room.

The designs were created with special attention devoted to type of material and intricacy of pattern. Each was based on an object found in a magazine picture.

Class members selected the 10 best designs to send to Edward Fields Inc., a firm the class visited on a field trip.

The designs were evaluated by Fields art department and sales staff members, and a critique was sent to Carl Lautzenheiser, class instructor.

"It was the first time we'd ever done anything like this," said Lautzenheiser. "There was such an abundance of quality work, we wanted to see what the professionals had to say."

DeMartini's project depicted a light

floral pattern on a white background to complement a white bathroom sink. An Edward Fields spokesman said "DeMartini's adaptation of the sink design is excellent."

At MSU, DeMartini is a member of the student chapter of American Society of Interior Designers. After graduation in June 1983, she plans to work for an architectural firm as an interior designer.
