

# Concert and ice cream social set for June 13

An old-fashioned band concert and ice cream social starts at 6:30 p.m. Sunday, June 13.

# Bicyclists to pedal for cancer society

Avid bicyclists and occasional riders alike will combine fun with sharing the cost of living by riding in the American Cancer Society's third annual Achievement Ride June 12.

Riders will have an opportunity to choose one of four sites to do their cycling: Oakland Community College's Oakridge Campus in Farmington; General Motors Technical Center, Warren; Rouge Park, Detroit; and Parklane Towers, Dearborn.

The Achievement Ride is unlike other bicycling events because cyclists can ride as many miles as they choose from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. Eddie Murray, Detroit area honorary crusade chairman, said "Riders solicit pledges for each mile they intend to complete."

"This year the individual who raises the largest amount of money at each site will win a Schwinn 10-speed bike," Murray said.

Each participant will receive an Achievement Ride patch. Those who bring in \$50 will be awarded a patch and T-shirt, and riders raising \$75 or more will also be given a bicycle water bottle. Rain date is June 19.

Dollars raised in the American Cancer Society Achievement Ride will be used to support programs designed to help people protect themselves against cancer; service for those with the dis-

ease, and research to determine the causes of cancer and ways to control it.
