A sell-out crowd of 1,000 local kitch-boring enthusiats are expected to be at the Premier Center for the bout. Many of the spectators will be denist of Roop, who is the director and instructor of the Nature's Way Martial Arts Academy in Rochester.

"I am ready for him (Macaruso)," Roop said.
