DANCEFIT — The Farmington Hills Parks and Recreation Department is offering a summer session of DanceFit at the Shawwassee Recreation Center, 30415 Shawwassee. DanceFit is a cardiovascular-fitness program that combines the basic elements of a good fitness workout with the fun of dancing, offering an exciting way to become physically fit. The session begins on Monday, June 28, and will continue on a Monday and Wednesday schedule through Aug. 4. The class will be held as follows: Session I, 9-10 a.m. or Session II 6:30-7:30 p.m. The fee is \$26 per participant.

TENNIS LESSONS — Learn the fundamentals of the game or improve your existing skills. Classes will meet twice each week in 50-minute sessions

for four weeks. All lessons will take place at Farmington and Harrison high schools. Participants are asked to bring a racquet and a can of new tennis balls for the lessons. The first session will begin Monday, June 21, and continue through July 16. The times vary throughout the day, youth classes are scheduled for 8 a.m. to 9 p.m. and 5 p.m. to 11 a.m. and 6-9 p.m. Fee for the eight-class session is \$18 per participant.

DAY CAMPING — We are offering day camping at Com-on-awanna Camp for youth ages 6-8 years and at Camp-us for those 9-12 years of age. The day camping experience will include camping activities, nature lore, fishing, hiking, environmental experiences, camp craft and more. The first session begins the week of June 21, and the camp will meet daily, Monday through Friday, 9:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. and on Thursday, 2-7 p.m. The site of the camp is Oakland Community College, Orchard Ridge Campus. Campers will need a sack lunch in addition to appropriate

"outdoor" clothing.

SENIOR ADULT DISCOUNT PICTURES — The Farmington Hills Parks and Recreation senior adult staff again is hosting, at The Gathering Place, senior discount card distribution. Oakland-Livingston Human Services Agency personnel will be at the center on Friday, June 18, from 9:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. and 1:30-3:30 p.m., to take your picture and issue identification cards. You will need to bring your Social Security number and proof of Oakland County residence, and you must be 60 years of age or older. The senior adult

center is located at the Mercy Center on 11 Mile Road, east of Middlebelt.

CAMP RAINBOW — Camp Rainbow is a summer day camp for all mentally and physically impaired individuals. The program operates Monday through Friday, 9:30 a.m. to 3 p.m., and offers a wide variety of recreation activities. Daily activities will incorporate socialization skills, gross and fine motor coordination and self-awareness. Additional activities will include swimming, field trips and overnight camping during specific sessions. The first session will begin July 6 and take place at Oak-

land Community College, Orchard Ridge Campus. The camper registration fee is \$30 per session. Register now.

SAILING/BOARD SAILING LESSONS — In cooperation with the Bloomfield Beach and Boat Facility, we are offering basic and intermediate sailing and board sailing. The sailing classes meet various hours for a three-hour session, once each week for seven weeks. There are four to five students/instructor for each boat, and upon suc-

cessful completion, participants will receive the American Red Cross sailing certificate. Fee is \$70 per person plus a \$4 textbook fee. The windsurfing meets in a two-hour blocks twice each week for two weeks. Students will begin on a dry-land simulator and then move on to rigging and actual water participation. All instructors are American Red Cross certified. Fee is \$55. The first session of classes will begin the week of June 27 and will take place on Elizabeth Lake in Waterford Township. Preregistration is mandatory, space is limited.

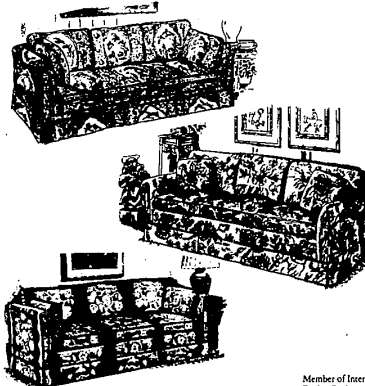

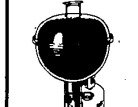
