

# Rochester's Roop rules kick boxing world

All the rigorous training Kerry Roop has gone through in the past few months paid off for him Monday night. At the Sterling Heights Premier Center, the Rochester resident stripped the Professional Karate Association-sanctioned world light heavyweight kick boxing championship from Dan Macaruso in a fourth-round disqualification.

Macaruso (30-1) was disqualified from the scheduled 12-round fight following the fourth round after the former world champion failed to make eight foot kicks in three of the four rounds. In professional kick boxing, a fighter must make eight "hard" foot kicks per round. If he fails in three rounds — regardless of their succession — he is disqualified.

Macaruso made seven kicks in the first round; six in the second, nine in the third and just seven in the fourth which gave the match to Roop (20-7).

"From the first round on I was aware that he (Macaruso) did not have all of his kicks in," said Roop following the fight.

"I was concentrating on those kicks, and making sure that I got mine in. I knew right from the first round that he was not getting all his kicks, and I knew if I kept punching him, he couldn't get any more (kicks) in."

From the opening seconds of the emotion-packed first round, Roop, the No. 4-ranked contender, took the fight to Macaruso.

Midway through the second round, Roop cornered the champion and started in with a series of punches to the body and the face. The punches began to affect the champ, and, more importantly, pinned him against the ropes and made it impossible to retaliate with either punches or kicks.

In the third round, Macaruso came out and seemed unaffected by the events of the previous round and came at Roop, landing some heavy kicks and scoring effectively to the body.

BUT THE third round was the champion's only moments of glory in the fight as the fourth round was a near repeat of the second.

Following the fourth round bell, Roop was declared the new light heavyweight champion, much to the pleasure of the 1,100 screaming Roop admirers in the audience.

Then Roop addressed the crowd over the public address system.

"I have spent a lot of time working towards this goal," Roop said, "and now that I have it, I'm not sure what I'll do with it."

Almost immediately, Macaruso came up to Roop and said, "I want a rematch."

That was discussed in Roop's locker

room during the post-fight celebrations.

"Make him wait two years for a rematch like he made you," one of the members of Roop's entourage suggested.

MACARUSO defeated Roop in a match about three years ago early in Roop's career and his lack of boxing knowhow showed against the veteran Macaruso.

But for this fight, Roop sought the

boxing expertise of Luther Burgess, a trainer from Detroit who has worked with many boxers in the Detroit area. Roop has been involved with karate for nine years, and kick boxing for about four years.

"I wanted this title since I began in karate nine years ago. This is all I wanted," he added.

The new champ said he was unsure about his plans for the future.

"I don't really know. I'll be 32 years old next month. I'll have to sleep on it."

My family (wife, two daughters and his mother) wants me to retire. I want to be a fight (kick boxing) promoter and a trainer. I guess I did this tonight for my students (Nature's Way Martial Arts Academy) so they could experience it. I knew what it was like (to fight in a championship fight), and I wanted my students to know what it is like."

ROOP IS the instructor and director of the Nature's Way Martial Arts Academy in Rochester and several of his students fought in bouts prior to the championship fight. Many others were in the audience.

"I had to stage this fight tonight just to be able to let the Detroit area see what kick boxing is all about," he said. "I had to train for the fight, I fought, I promoted, I made up the program and I sold tickets. But I'm happy. I am really happy."

In the preliminary bouts: Pat Ristola (Madison Heights) won by a technical knockout over Steve Sebo (Davison).

Rick Simmons (Grand Rapids) won by a decision over Ronny Morrison (Kitchener, Ontario).

**CITY OF LATHRUP VILLAGE**  
2ND AMENDMENT TO REVISED ZONING ORDINANCE NO. 230  
(Ordinance No. 233)  
THE CITY OF LATHRUP VILLAGE ORDAINS:  
I. TITLE AND PURPOSE  
The Title of the Ordinance is "2nd Amendment to Revised Zoning Ordinance No. 230" and its purpose is to add audio/visual equipment shops to the list of Class II Uses and delete bookstores from the list of Class IV Uses.  
II. AMENDMENTS TO ORDINANCE  
Section 2102 of Revised Zoning Ordinance No. 230 is amended by the inclusion of an additional use classified as Class II as item 43 as follows: 43. Audio/visual equipment shops, but not amusement arcades. Section 2302 of said Ordinance is amended by deleting Item 6, Bookstores, as a Class IV Use.  
III. MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS  
The provisions hereof are declared to be severable pursuant to Section 7.8 of the Charter of this City and shall become effective on June 18, 1982.
