Dollars raised in the Achievement Ride will be used to support programs designed to help people protect themselves against cancer, provide services for cancer victum, and research the causes of cancer.

In last year's ride, Magrie rode six miles, earning 3348, the second-largest amount turned in at the OCC site. Riders participating in the OCC bike-athon and rides held simultaneously at the General Motors Technical Center in Warren, Rouge Park in Detroit and Parklane Towers in Dearborn, rode as many miles as they chose between 8 am. and 3 p.m.

"Sister Elizabeth Girardot kiled of cancer this year and I know so many other sisters who've died of cancer," Magrie said. "I thought this was a good chance to do something for them.

"Many of my students made pledges for the ride. The different classes made pledges, and individual students made donations, too," Magrie added.

"I was 45 on Tuesday. Most people think I look and sound like I'm in my 20s or 30s. My students keep me young, and I love being a sister. "
