"Robin Hood" (1922), 8 p.m. Friday at the Fox Theatre, 2211 Woodward in Detroit, phone 537-2560, tickets priced at \$10.50, \$8.50, \$6.50. You've probably never seen this "Robin Hood," which stars Douglas Fairbanks Sr. No one has for 50 years. But perhaps you remember D.W. Griffith's "Intolerance" (1916), or Joseph Mankiewicz's "Cleopatra" (1936). Those films come to mind because of their memorable sets — palaces of Belshazzar, Egypt and Rome. Yet none was larger than the set created for "Robin Hood." Granted, quantity does not equal, but "Robin Hood" sounds like a must-see, nonetheless.

Like Abel Gance's "Napoleon" (1927) — which was resurrected two years ago and played before standing-room-only crowds at New York's Radio City Music Hall — "Robin Hood" has been restored in 35mm by film collector Raymond Rohauer. And like "Napoleon," "Robin Hood" will be accompanied by a musical score — this one original — performed by the 36-piece Ann Arbor Chamber Orchestra. Carl Daehler conducts. And beginning at 7:15 p.m., Dennis James will perform on the Fox Theatre's Wurlitzer pipe organ.
