A MIDSUMMER NIGHT'S SEX COMEDY (PG). Woody Allen returns after a long hibernation with light period comedy, full of good fun and optimism. Stars Woody Allen, Mia Farrow, Jose Ferrer, Julie Hagerty, Tony Roberts and Mary Steenburgen, written and directed by Woody Allen.

ANNIE (PG). The successful Broadway musical is expanded and brought to the screen by director John Huston, with talented Aileen Quinn as Annie and Albert Finney and Carol Burnett.

AUTHOR, AUTHOR (PG). Wife walks out on Broadway playwright leaving him with five children (from different marriages) to raise and vice versa.

BAMBI (G). Re-release of Disney's classic film about a young deer and his forest friends.

BLADE RUNNER (R). Harrison Ford is a detective hunting four defective human replicants who have become killers. Set in Los Angeles in the year 2020.

DAS BOOT (THE BOAT) (R). Realistic and powerful drama of experiences of a German submarine crew during World War II.

DINNER (R). Comedy drama set in 1959 about five friends and their difficult transition into manhood.

DYNAMITE CHICKEN (R). Richard Pryor heads an all star cast from the 60s in a comic barrage of mixed media. Also features the Ace Trucking Co., Fred Willard, John Lennon and Yoko Ono, Andy Warhol, Al Goldstein and more.

E.T. THE EXTRA-TERRESTRIAL (PG). Steven Spielberg's best film yet, and probably the best film of the year, develops story of an alien being stranded on earth and befriended by a young boy.

FIREFOX (PG). Clint Eastwood is an American pilot of an espionage mission to steal the Soviets' most sophisticated warplane.

GREGORY'S GIRL (PG). Romantic comedy about an unlikely 16-year-old romance whose recent infatuation with the opposite sex has caused him to relegate any other considerations unimportant or positively nonexistent.

POLTERGEIST (PG). Steven Spielberg film is a succession of special effects as suburban family is terrorized by spirits in their home.

ROCKY III (PG). Sylvester Stallone as Rocky faces the challenge of staying on top. Cast includes regulars from the "Rocky" saga: Talia Shire, Burgess Meredith and Carl Weathers.

THE SECRET OF NIMH (G). Animated film of fantasy and mystery follows adventures of a brave widowed mouse.

STAR TREK II: THE WRATH OF KHAN (PG). Admiral Kirk and the whole Enterprise crew — Spock, McCoy, Scotty and Sulu — are back and on a perilous mission against an old enemy (Ricardo Montalban).

THE THING (R). John Carpenter movie is sci-fi horror story about creature from outer space that attacks an Antarctic research team and threatens all mankind.

Harris, Bertini, Mangione, Rich play at Festival this week

Grammy winner Emmylou Harris brings her country songs to the Meadow Brook Music Festival tonight. Hank Williams Jr., following in his father's footsteps to become another country music great, opens the show.

On Thursday and Sunday, Gary Bertini, music adviser for the Detroit Symphony Orchestra, will conduct the Kenneth Jewell Chorale in Ravel's "Daphnis and Chloe." Pianists Boris Berman performs Mozart's Concerto No. 12, 12th night.

Chuck Mangione plays flugelhorn and trumpet with his group on Friday. The contemporary jazz musician became well known playing "Give It All You Got" at the 1980 Winter Olympics at Lake Placid, New York.

Drummer Buddy Rich and his band share the Meadow Brook stage with Woody Herman and His Thundering Herd on Saturday.

The Thursday/Sunday symphonic concerts are co-sponsored by WQRS-FM. The Detroit News presents the Friday Variety Series, and the Detroit Free Press presents the Saturday Variety/Pops Series.

Evening concerts begin at 8 p.m. All concerts are held in the Baldwin Pavilion on the Oakland University Campus

in Rochester. Entrances are on Walton Boulevard and Adams Road.

More than 7,000 people can be seated in the pavilion and the lawn. The grounds are open two hours before evening concerts for picnicking or dining at the Trumbull Terrace.
