Geer sald if he really worked at it he probably could pump his own gas, but it'd be such a time-consuming process persons waiting to use the pump would grow impatient waiting for him. Other handicapped persons, such as quadriplegics, aren't as fortunate. Geer was able-bodied up until seven years ago when a still-unexplained spinal infection struck, leaving him without use of his legs. This is his first job

in seven years, in part because his physical limitation limits the amount of time he can sit comfortably at a job and partly because employers were convinced he couldn't perform the job. He landed the job at the gas station in March because he's a high-school friend of Keller.

"I APPRECIATE the opportunity to work," Keller said. "This way I can get some credit established and I can meet more of the public."

It's important for the handicapped to socialize with other handicapped persons in a support group, Geer said, because "there are certain feelings I can talk about that you can only discuss with a person in a similar situation."

On the other hand, Geer said, "you must to socialize with anybody and everybody — you don't want to limit yourself." Or that matter, he said, feel sorry for yourself. Without whining about his handicap, Geer said there are times he's annoyed by things designed for the general pub-

by things designed for the general pub-lic that are inaccessible to the handi-capped. Automatic teller banking ma-

chines, for example, Geer sald, are unwieldly for persons in a wheelchair because the screen can't be read from the height of the chair. His comments are stronger about business places with an inadequate number of handicapped parking spaces or drivers without a handicap who use the parking spaces.

When asked if he's glad he had the use of his legs for the first 21 years of his life, Geer said the never thinks in those terms.

"I just do what I can and forget what it used to be," Geer said. "I live life the way it is the best way I can."
