PICNIC PACS - Do you need additional games for your picnic or family reunion? We have volleyball, badminton, horseshoes, softball, frisbees and more included in our "Picnic Pac." To reserve your Pac, contact the Parks and Recreation office at least 48 hours in advance. A \$20 deposit is required. The fee is \$4 per weekend or \$5 per weekday rental.

YOUTH SOCCER REGISTRATION - All kindergarten through fifth grade boys and girls are eligible to become participants in our fall soccer program. Teams will be formed by neighborhoods in three grade divisions. Games will be played on Saturdays with teams participating once each week. A five-game schedule will be completed beginning Saturday, Sept. 11. Registration will end with a one-time Saturday registration, Aug. 14 from 9 a.m.-noon, at the Parks and Recreation office. Fee is \$10 per participant.

COMMUNITY CHORUS - The Farmington Hills Community Chorus will begin its fall season with open rehearsals beginning Tuesday, Sept. 7 from 7:30-9:30 p.m. All adults and high school students who enjoy music are welcome to attend. The 13-week session will conclude with a holiday concert for the community. The site of rehearsals is North Farmington High School. The registration fee is \$18 per participant, which includes music. You

may register at the Farmington Hills Parks and Recreation Office or up through the third rehearsal.

SENIOR ADULT FOOD CO-OP - The Senior Adult Food Co-op continues to be a great success. The bimonthly program offers a great variety of vegetables which adds up to a substantial savings. The initial membership fee is \$1 and the cost of the bimonthly food bag is \$3. We ask that members help out periodically if they are able.
