

Technologists offered classes

Medical technologists interested in updating their skills are invited to enroll in clinical myology and parasitology classes offered by Mercy College of Detroit's Continuing Education Department this fall. The classes, the fourth in a series of Update programs, begin Sept. 13 and continue through Nov. 23.

The two courses are designed to reacquaint and refresh medical technologists in the constantly changing field of clinical laboratory medicine by introducing new procedures, terminology, isolation techniques and quality control.

Each course involves 20 hours of classroom instruction and includes both lecture and laboratory time. "Student participation in the learning process is critical; therefore, some independent study is involved," said Carole Deyer, an assistant professor of medical technology at Mercy and coordinator of the Update programs.

Teachers for the Update will be W. Faenor Lewis, a clinical micro-biologist at Providence Hospital, and Dr. Lorraine Renkowski, a Mercy professor of medical technology. The myology course is scheduled for the first five

weeks, from Sept. 13 through Oct. 12. The parasitology class is to be held the first five weeks from Oct. 25 through Nov. 23.

"Last year's students commented that 25 percent of the material covered in the Update was new material, even those students whose training had been fairly recent," said Peggy Posa, continuing education director.

All sessions will be held on Monday and Tuesday evenings, 7-9 p.m. in Mercy's modern Health Science Center.

Each program has been approved for 2.0 Continuing Education Units (CEUs), or 4.0 CEUs for both by the college. A permanent record of this achievement will be kept on file at Mercy. In addition, each participant will receive a certificate. The cost of each course is \$125, or \$225 for both; enrollment is limited. Registrations will be accepted until Sept. 3.




