COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS (Summary)

A regular meeting of the Farmington City Council was called to order at 8:05 p.m. on August 16, 1982, by Mayor Bennett in Council Chambers, 23609 Liberty Street, Farmington, Michigan.

PRESENT: Mayor Bennett, Councilmen Hartscock, Mitchell, Tupper.

ABSENT: Councilman Yoder.

CITY OFFICIALS PRESENT: City Manager Deadman, Director Billing, Li, Lauff, Attorney Kelly, City Clerk Bushy.

Minutes of previous meetings were approved.

Minutes of other boards were received and/or filed.

Council supported Senate Bill 585 which would limit municipal liability in civil rights cases.

Council granted a fence variance to Ronald McKenzie, owner of property at 23820 Warner Street.

Council approved the Farmington Racquet Club's request for a Tent Sale on August 21, 1982.

Council tabled request for support of the Evergreen-Farmington Facilities Plan until an administrative recommendation can be prepared.

CENTER WEEK - September 5 - 11, 1982

Council authorized the City Manager to prepare Resolution No. 1 of the Special Assessment process concerning the flooding problem in the Liberty/State Street area.

Council awarded the contract for the 1982 Road Construction Program to the low bidder, Detroit Concrete Products Corporation of Novi, Michigan, in the amount of \$45,318.91.

Ordinance No. C-495-82, removing "No Parking" on Slocum Street in front of the Post Office, was introduced.

The City Manager presented Council with a progress report on cable television.

Public comments were heard relative to the Liberty/State Street area flooding problem.

Council advised the City Manager that either August 25 or September 8, 1982, would be acceptable for a joint meeting with the Farmington Hills City Council concerning the District Library's request to place a proposal on the November ballot.

Monthly bills were approved for payment.

Meeting adjourned at 9:35 p.m.
