DRIED/SILK FLOWER ARRANGEMENTS—Oval arrangements suitable for trill and/or can be trimmed for the holidays. Natural colors (if desired, gold added for holiday dress). Large arrangements, Oct. 27 10-noon, \$3. Materials fee for instructor approximately \$20. Medium arrangement Oct. 27, 1-3 p.m., \$3. Materials fee due instructor, approximately, \$15.*

WREATH—Wednesday, Nov. 3, 1-3 p.m., \$3. Great for holidays, can be used all season. Teacher will furnish supplies at \$10 per wreath.*

FABRIC FRAMES—Friday, Sept. 24, 9:30-11:30, Room 1, \$3. Learn the technique for making popular fabric frames. A 6" oval picture frame will be made in class. Bring the following supplies, ¼ yard calico print and one yard
