In an informal Observer & Eccentric survey Thursday, the consensus showed Extra-Strength Tylenol was a good product that did what it was advertised to do. "I've used it for years and it has all said they wouldn't buy the capsules in the form of the product even if it were available. Many are steering clear of the entire Tylenol line," said a pharmacist at Warren purchased a bottle of Extra-Strength Tylenol tablets from Elfron Drugs in Orchard Mall despite the nationwide publicity surrounding the pain reliever.

But some people are still confused between the tablets and the capsules," he said. "I like the Tylenol product because it doesn't have any aspirin and it works. I have a sore back and I need it. I don't know if there will be any more capsules with the tablets, I hope," Capocasa said.

DAVID EFROS, a pharmacist and one of the owners of Efros drugs, said all the Extra-Strength Tylenol capsules have been pulled from the shelves in the store, but the tablets are still for sale.

"This has really become a major concern of the people," Efros said.

"Up until yesterday, I wasn't really

concerned with keeping the tablets on the shelves," Efros said. On Wednesday, police in Philadelphia called the death of a college student "Tylenol-cyanide related."

Tylenol, the brand name of a pain reliever made without aspirin by Johnson & Johnson, is one of the largest selling pain relievers nationwide and at Efros Drugs.

"We sell so much of it (Tylenol), we order it on a weekly basis," Efros said.

"WE'RE STILL selling the tablets because they are virtually unalterable. If someone was to put something in the tablets, you could really tell the difference," Efros said.

"If there is one thing good that will come out of this is that people are starting to look a little more closely at virtually everything they buy, which they should. But we have seen a real change in the way people are buying products," Efros added.

Several people interviewed said they did not use the product and never would.

Jeff Goldstein of Farmington Hills said he did not use the product but his parents had. Now he won't buy Tylenol, he said, and said his parents wouldn't either.

Steve Weisberg, Erin Steingold,

Jodi Levenson and Linda Rosenfeld, all teenagers from West Bloomfield, agreed they would not use the product because they "don't want to die."


"I have used the product before because of it not containing any aspirin and it cured my headache," Levenson said.

Tylenol was a good product, but

now no one will buy it because they are scared," Heather Lawrence of West Bloomfield said.

Ann Rusk of Walled Lake agreed with Lawrence's assessment.

"There is no way I will buy the Tylenol brand name until something gets cleared up in this matter. I would be too scared to use it," she said.


