84 partners hired by the company in 1981 were men. "It's strange that in this day and age, they didn't hire at least one token female," she said.

Citing the information from the com-pany's annual report, Reynolds added "I also found it interesting that there were only three blacks (among the new partners)."

TRUSTEE ELIZABETH Hawthorne said, "Il we're spending a lot of money (the firm's fee is \$38,000), we have every right to ask the company what their affirmative action policies are."

Trustee Edward Pappas disagreed.
"I think we should find out how many women they've hired in the past five to seven years" before taking action, he said.

OCC President Robert F. Roelofs agreed to conduct a survey of "several representative auditing firms" to learn more about their minority hiring practices.


