Couple celebrate 75th anniversary

Dr. Joseph Nosanchuk of Farmington Hills is making preparations to celebrate his parents' 75th wedding anniversary.

About 450 guests are expected at the gathering, which will honor 91-year-old Ida and 94-year-old Jacob Nosanchuk, who were both born in Ruble, Russia and married there on Nov. 28, 1907.

Two of their children, Rose Raskin, now deceased, and Joseph, now a Pontiac physician, were born in Russia. Another daughter, Ann Meyers, was born later in Detroit.

"My parents still live in their own home in Oak Park," Nosanchuk said. "My mother, though practically blind, does the cooking, and my father still drives his 1969 Buick. His driver's license will expire in 1988."

Among the diamond wedding anniversary guests will be the couple's two children, eight grandchildren, 19 great-grandchildren and a 10-month-old great-granddaughter.

"Their 96-year-old cousin will attend the party, but a 105-year-old cousin from New York won't be able to attend because of ill health," Nosanchuk said.

JACOB NOSANCHUK immigrated to the United States in 1913 seeking a better life for his family, whom he was forced to leave behind temporarily.

During World War I he filled his life with work and prayer, spending every free hour as a volunteer for war relief organizations.

Meanwhile, his wife and two children struggled for their existence. She worked in the field as a potato digger, with little food, no doctors, living one day at a time, "leaving the rest to God, praying that he would help us," she said.

The couple picked up the threads of their marriage about two years after the war and built their life around a verse from Proverbs, "Those who pursue giving charity and good deeds are rewarded with life, wealth, and honor."

On their 73rd wedding anniversary they made a contribution to the reclamation of one acre of land in Moshav Dahan, Israel, under the auspices of the Jewish National Fund (JNF).

Previous they planted a forest of 10,000 trees on a one-acre site in the Galilee.

Ida Nosanchuk is a life member of JNF and a life member of the Women's Division of Bar-Ilan University. She is affiliated with Hadassah, Women of Shaare Zedek Hospital in Jerusalem, Mizrahi Women, Jewish Home for the Aged and Detroit House of Shelter.

JACOB NOSANCHUK is life member of Zager-Stone Lodge of B'nai B'rith and a member of Hadassah Associates.

He is honorary president of the Kollel Institute for advanced learning and honorary president of Congregation B'nai Jacob and Ezra Achin Turover Society. He served as president of Congregation B'nai Jacob for more than 25 years and is vice president of Congregation Mishkan Israel Nusach H'Ari. He has served as gabbai of Turover Cemetery for 35 years and has been on the board of Chesed Shel Emes for 50 years.

The couple have planted four groves in Israel, one honoring the 35th wedding anniversary of their son and daughter-in-law. They dedicated a room in Shaare Zedek Hospital in memory of their deceased daughter and have established the Raskin Free Loan Fund.

They have endowed a room in United Old Age Home in Jerusalem and a dormitory and classroom in Bar-Ilan University.

They are longtime supporters of Yeshivah Beth Yehudah and are State of Israel Bond guardians.

Alcoholism Education offered in seminary

Alcoholism as a family disease will be the focus of an alcoholism education course in St. John's Provincial Seminary, Plymouth, on Thursdays from 3:20-5:20 p.m. beginning Dec. 9. The course, conducted by Rose Teresa Izzo, may be taken for credit or audit by anyone interested and qualified.

Chemical dependency is a wholistic disease affecting the entire family, Sister Izzo said, and unemployment is increasing that dependency, especially alcoholism.

Reflecting on her four-year experience as a counselor in the in-patient Alcoholism Treatment Program at St. Joseph Hospital, Mt. Clemens, Sister Izzo said, "It's so important that people in helping services understand the disease

and its treatment in the context of the family.

"In this course, we will identify the symptoms of alcoholism and its effects on the family. We will also learn how to conduct an intervention and find treatment, besides reviewing the dynamics of recovery and reconstruction," she said.

The course will also include student visits to an alcoholic treatment center and dialogue with a staff person; attendance at an open Alcoholics Anonymous meeting and an Alano or Alateen meeting; guest lectures, films and process experiences.
