"I was in the Seventh Division compariment at chow when it all broke loose on the outside.
"I heard on explosion and looked out the porthole across the channel to see some of our planes afire. It was then I saw an unknown plane make a circle and go over the hangar. Then I saw the shiney bombs go down from the plane. There was another terrific explosion.
"I was mad, everyone else was mad. It was no time at all that we were firing at them. It was a rugged battle while it lasted."

Lester Reitz was a 22 year-old machinist's mate list class aboard the USS
Pennsylvania when he made that journal entry on Dec. 7, 1941.
Now 63, Reitz lives in Redford Township with his wife, Renee, and Amy, 25,
the youngest of their three daughters.
His war memorabilia is neatly packneged to help recall those 41-year-old
memories. There's a photo album
showing sailors aboard ship at attention on deck, uniforms blowing in the
breeze, and others of clean-cut young
men playfully mugging under palm
trees on the beach. Nicknames like

It's a time that Relix ham't thought much about lately, he admits. Even his wife of \$1 years says she has never heard some of the stories before.

With little prompting, Relix's memory is back to Aug, 30, 1940, the day be enlisted in the U.S. Navy at Norfolk, Va.

"After boot camp, we went by train to Bremerton, Wash., where we boarded the Penasylvania.

"We were in and out of Pearl Harbor many times," he said. "We'd be in port a few days, then go back at seo.

"At the time of the attack, we were in dry dock, When it came about that Sunday morning, I was serving chow. It was about 10 to 8.

"I heard the explosion and looked out starboard side porthole and saw bombs dropping — then a plane with torpedos. I saw the red sun on the side of the plane."

Because of their training, Relix says, there was no panic.

"Everybody went right to their stations, Nobody cried, I went to generate."

"I was down there from 10 to 8 until When he stood on deck at midafter-noon, the sight was devastating.

"The Oklahoma was capsized, the Arbona was sunk and on fire. The ship in the spot where we were supposed to be was capsized. The California was sunk. The Nevada was sunk, the West Virginia was sunk. All of them were doodling in the water."

Damage to the Pennsylvania was minimal.
"We took one 500-pound bomb star-

pamage to the Pennsylvania was minimal.

"We took one 500-pound bomb starboard," he said. "We couldn't sink because we were in dry dock. Fifty-seven men were killed on our ship."

About 300 of the 3,000 men assigned to the Pennsylvania were off ship attending church services when the nitack started. Relix said.

Eight, carloads of ammunition were spend during the battle.

"We got credit for shooting down 18 Japanese planes," he said. "They (Japanese) didn't bother us much because we were in dry dock and they couldn't shik us.

"I lost quite a few buddles. Guys I went on the beach with a lot."

Reitz's journal indicates that the

Pennsylvania left Pearl Harbor on Dec. 20, 1941.

"We left the dock and out the channel we went, past the Newada which was grounded in the channel and they sent up loud cheers to us to do our stuff. On we went out to sea then it got dark and who knew what would come next. Would it be torpedox, bombs or shells? We looked and watched for the enemy."

That particular cruise end stateside at San Francisco, where the Pennsylvania was relitted with guns before returning to sea for battle.

Over the next four years, Reitz and the Pennsylvania saw action in the Pacific, from the Aleutian Islands in the north to the Marshall Islands, Saipan and Guam in the south.

'I never suffered any injuries, and the ship never suffered any more damage after Pearl Harbor,' he said.

Reitz was bonorably discharged JUZ, 1948, Having contracted rheumatic fever in the South Pacific, he was discharged from the U.S. Mayal Hospital at Treasure Island, San Francisco after dectors detected a heart mu'on Hawaif, since the service,' he said. "But I would go. It would be nice."
