Director Robert Aldrich's ambitious war drama is overly long, but some comic relief and fine performances from Lee Marvin and a cast of irregu-

lars hold the film together. Jim Brown, John Cassavetes, Charles Bronson, Donald Sutherland and even singer Trini Lopez are believable as bad guys, and a supporting cast that includes Robert Ryan and Ernest Borgnine enhances the credibility. By film's end you'll find yourself rooting for these anti-heroes. Telly Savalas also stars. Rating: \$2.90.
