Returning to their Southfield home, the couple found themselves replacing everything from the furniture and carpeting to the furnace. Food and all household products had to be chemical free.

Already some of the 50 foods she found she was allergic to aren't giving her unpleasant reactions' anymore.


"I can eat cheese again without it giving me a sore throat and swelling," she said.


