Governor saves official's job

In one of his last decisions as gover-nor, William Milliken ruled Thursday that West Bioomileid Township Treas-urer Andrew Lobodocky — although guilty of official misconduct — may re-main in office.

main in office. He placed Lobodocky on probation for the rest of his term which ends No-

for the rest of List term which ends No-vember, 1984. Probation conditions established by Milliken, whose last official day as gov-ernor was Friday, are that Lobodecky continue to take Antabase tablets as re-quired on a weekly basis in the pres-ence of township Supervisor John Doberty or his designee. Antabuse is a drug causing severe ill-ness if a leohol is consumed. Brighton Hospital also must report periodically that the treasurer is con-tinuing an alcoholic rehabilitation pro-gram.

inuing an alcoholic rehabilitation pro-gram. In June, the township board peti-tioned the governor to remove Lobo-docky from office. It charged that on May 28, following lunch at Darlin Lill's Restaurant in Farmington Hills, he re-turned to town hall intoxicated and made obscene sexual advances toward live female township employees. Doherty's secretary, Joan Lauzon, said the trassurer offered her money for soc, swept the papers of her desk, used wile language, chowed a file folder and banged his head against the wall.
