This is the time of year we would expect to see it. This year we expect to see many more cases," said Dr. Donald Lawrenchuk, saistiant medical director of the Wayne County Heaith Department. One case of Influenza Type A — the more serious type of flu strain that brings fevers of more than 101 degrees — has been con-firmed in Wayne County, and one other is supsected in Oakland County, according to Dr. Lawrenchuk. Altogether, 12 cases of Type A flu have been reported broughout Michigan, and no cases of the more common Type B flu, he said.

Washington, Virginia, Texas, Tonnesseo, Pensylvana, Oregon, New York and Alas-ka had outbreaks of influenza Type +, be-fore Michigan, county officials said.
