Childhood centers take enrollment for new term

Developmental programs are available at each center for children 3-5 years of age. Classes meet either two or three times a week for approximately 2 1/2 hours. Cognitive, social-emotional, gross and fine motor development is stressed. A specially equipped gym is part of the children's daily schedule.

Each class has a maximum of 16 children with one teacher and one aide. A parent-toddler program for children 2-3 years to 3 years is being offered for the first time. This class meets once a week for 90 minutes and gives parents and children a chance to interact together in a structured environment.

Women help one another with empathy training

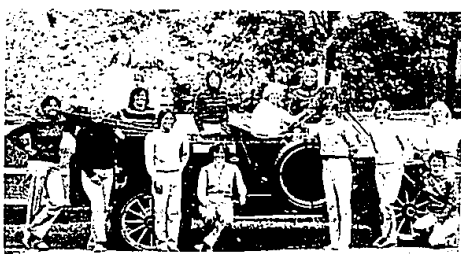

Group interviews will be held at 10 a.m. on Jan. 17, 18 and 19. The eight-week empathy training course will meet from 9 a.m. until noon on Mondays and Wednesdays beginning Jan. 31.

Designed for those with an interest in helping women discover their potential, participants will study to develop empathy listening skills and problem-solving techniques. Upon successful completion of the intensive training sessions, they are requested to serve as volunteer peer counselors three hours a week for a minimum of four months.

Individuals pay for 2.5 institutional credits of instruction. Those interested may call or visit the center located in the second house south of the Schoolcraft Campus on Haggerty Road in Livonia, 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Monday through Friday and 7-9 p.m. on Wednesdays.

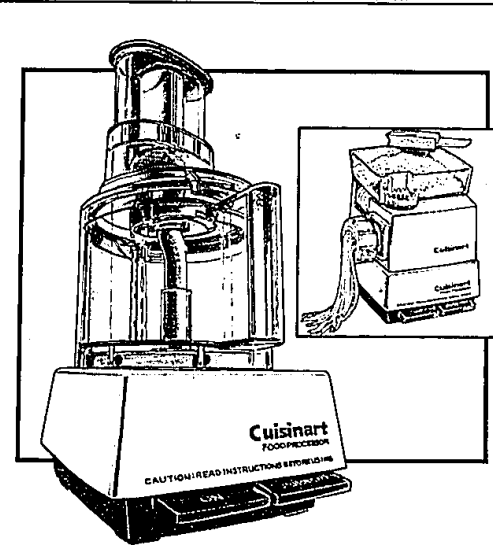
