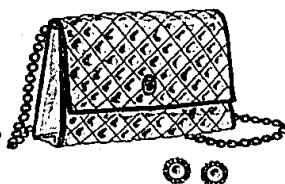

Mark-downs are regular events in Second Edition

All of the items in Second Edition are being knocked down again for the small resale shop's January sale.

The shop, on the second floor of Farmington Community Center, was established two years ago to bring ad-

ditional revenue to the center.

Operated by a crew of volunteers under the direction of Mary Fezzy and Virginia Pezzy, the Second Edition features used clothing for all ages which has been donated for sale or placed on consignment. All apparel is clean, in good condition, seasonally stylish and priced to sell.

The shop differs from other resale stores in that if a donated item remains unsold for 30 days, it is marked down. If it hasn't sold at the end of six weeks, it is donated to a charity.

This system means better turnover of merchandise, seasonal styles, and additional bargains for its customers.

"The two-fold effect benefits charities where the clothes are so desperately needed and are so greatly appreciated," said Fezzy.

Clothing may be donated to the shop with the proceeds going entirely to the Farmington Community Center or placed on consignment with the donor

receiving 50 percent of the purchase price. Out-and-out donations are encouraged and the donor receives a receipt for income tax purposes.

"The volunteers have been busy during the first week of January marking down all winter items for quick sale," said Gretchen Cudini, a center volunteer who works regularly at the resale shop.

"Customers will not only find bargains on clothes for everyday needs, but also apparel for special occasions. The selection includes bridal gowns, long and short party dresses and designer clothes.

"A special attraction in January is the low prices on women's winter coats and jackets, men's jackets, and boys apparel sizes 14-16," she said.

Second Edition is open from 11:30 a.m. to 2 p.m. weekdays and 10 a.m. to noon Saturday. Farmington Community Center is at 24705 Farmington Road.

Admission is \$3, or \$2 for students, at the door. A reception for the artists follows the concert.

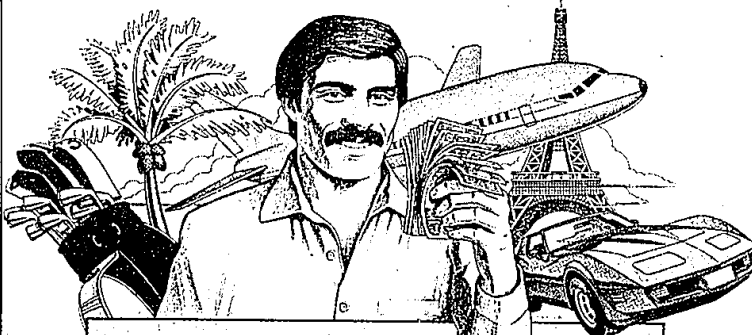

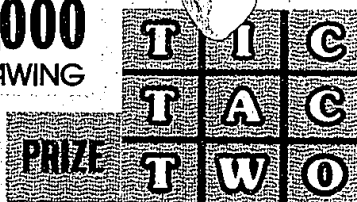
