Mall exhibits 200 Joe Clark photos

More than 200 photographs by Joe Clark, the award-winning "hillbilly snaphooter," will be on exhibit Feb. 13 at Somerset Mall, Big Beaver and Coolidge Road in Troy.

Clark, long-time Farmington Hills resident, will be at the mall in person 7-9 p.m. Thursday, Feb. 3.

He will autograph his books from 1-3 p.m. Friday and Saturday, Feb. 4 and 5; and from 2-4 p.m. Sunday, Feb. 6.

Also on Feb. 5, from 2 to 4 p.m., the Lost World String Band will perform for the Sunday Concert series.

THE ONE-MAN exhibit covers the past 40 years of Clark's work. It is open to the public at no charge during regular mall hours. Regular hours are noon to 5 p.m. Sundays; 10 a.m. to 9 p.m. Mondays, Thursdays and Fridays; and 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. other days.

Clark was born in Cumberland Gap in the Blue Ridge Mountains of Tennessee. He has covered almost every type of assignment during his prolific career, including the 1967 riots, the Bradley ship disaster in Lake Michigan, a West Virginia mountain school integration and hunting dog field trials.

His work has appeared in many national magazines, and he had a 28-year contract to take photographs for the Jack Daniel's bourbon company.

Clark is also a writer, philosopher, poet and storyteller. He has written more than 20 books, many of which are

THE ARTIST came to Detroit in 1932 and worked as night watchman at Hudson's. He first took pictures on vacation in Tennessee to show his vacation workers, using a borrowed camera. Three of his early photographs appeared in Coronet Magazine.

This early success prompted Clark to purchase a used camera and to read about photography. He took shots of Hudson's that were put on exhibit.

A photo editor from Life Magazine saw the pictures and told Clark to send him samples of his work. The magazine published the photographs Clark took of a mountain funeral in Tennessee as a full spread series and paid him \$300.
