Insurance should cover more than just funeral

N THIS FINAL series we will discuss insurance, estate plan-ning and retirement.

INSURANCE:

It is necessary for you to check five types of insurance: life, health, disability, homeowners and automobile. Here are some

- health, disability, homeowners and automobile. Here are some general guidelines.

 Make sure your life insurance is adequate. The life insurance proceeds should be sufficient to cover immediate cash needs (funeral costs, emergency funds, debt repayment and educational costs) as well as illetime income needs of the surviving family.

 You should have major medical insurance with high limits.

 Your disability policy should cover both accident and sickness, and should provide adequate monthly income until 65.

 If you own a home, it should be insured for today's replacement costs.

 Your automobile-liability insurance should be sufficient.
 Also make sure that you are not overinsured on collision.

 ESTATE PLANNING:

 Make sure that all the adult members of your family have valid wills.
- All wills must be updated to take advantage of the 1981 tax
- Both spouses must have an adequate estate plan.

 It is wise to appoint a trustee to take care of your estate in the event of an unlimely death.

- You should make provision for a retirement that promises to be financially comfortable.
 Make sure that the retirement funds are invested properly for growth and security. Also, it is highly desirable that the retirement income be inflation-resistant.


Generally, as in previous years, the Form 1040 is for those taxpayers who itemize deductions or claim such tax credits as child care, energy, political contributions and investment credit.
