Walk in their shoes before judging them

An old Indian saying reminds us not to judge another until we have walked a mile in his moccasins. This same advice has been reiterated in a variety of phrases, but its worth remains intact.

Dustin Hoffman discovered something of this truth in his role as "Tootsie." For those who have not seen the movie, "Tootsie" is the story of what happens to an out-of-work actor who masquerades as a woman in order to get a job. The sham succeeds, and he/she lands a female role in a television show.

Having walked in a woman's shoes for a time he comes to a new sense of who he is as a man and comes to a different view of woman.

The story is as challenging as it is entertaining. What would happen if each of us were to walk in the moccasins of any number of people for a time. For those who can see the experience may provide a new vision of ourselves as well as a greater appreciation of those in whose shoes we have traveled.

THERE ARE SOME places in life where once having been there we can no longer view life in the same way, and the shoes of another are one of these places.

How might we come to look upon the ADC recipient if we had to buy our food with a handout? And how might we come to see ourselves through the eyes of such people.

Yes, there are welfare cheats, but that does not lessen the pain or the humiliation of those who are truly in need. If we don't know that, we might dare to walk in their shoes.

And how about the out-of-work, black, or white, or brown or yellow, red or whatever? They look so lazy standing around street corners.

But how might they look to one who knows from experience what it is to be without work when one wants it? How

might they appear to one who has stood on that street corner hoping against hope that someone will hire him.

AND HOW different their plight might appear to one who has been turned down due to lack of qualifications when the education for such qualifications has not been available because they lived in the wrong neighborhood — the only one available to them? And how might we come to view ourselves through any one pair of those desperate eyes?

And then there is the gay population — those who are "tick" or "weird" or whatever other tag has been attached to them. How do such people look when seen from the only line of vision open to those who live in that lonely world on the other side of the family in which they grew up?

How might we come to see such people if we lived in their world even for a short time? And how might we see ourselves when viewed from the perspective of one who hides in fear because exposure to something set in them before the age of 4 would mean the loss of their job and rejection by those they love, let alone the rest of their society?

No wonder they form their ghetto. We are afraid to have them on our side of the street, and they know it.

There are many other roles we might try out, lots of moccasins to step into. For those who teach, there are students. For students, there are instructors.

For management, there is labor and for labor the shoes of a boss. For the young, there are the shoes of the old, and even for the old, there are the shoes of the young of today's world.

It might pinch our feet to walk in the shoes of another, but to fail to do so — at least in our imagination — leaves an awful lot of people conducting our lives very wrong judgments just as surely as it leaves us condemned to our own narrowness.

Aspirin can be helpful in slowing of cataracts

Dear Jo:

My doctor has told me to take two aspirins, twice a day, to slow down the growth of my cataracts. Is this something new in the treatment of cataracts in older persons? And is it safe to take four aspirins a day?

Dear B.F.:

According to research studies done by several ophthalmologists (doctors who specialize in the treatment of eye conditions) the use of two aspirins, taken twice daily, is a factor in slowing down the growth of cataracts in older persons.

Dr. Edward Cattler, professor of ophthalmology at Yale University, School of Medicine, reported the findings of several studies done on the subject of the use of aspirin as a preventative to cataracts at the 1980 American Academy of Ophthalmology meeting in Chicago.

He stressed that the taking of aspirin does slow down their formation, but does not reverse the changes that have already taken place, nor does it help advanced cataracts.

So, to answer your question on "is this a new treatment of cataracts?" the answer is yes. Your question as to the safety of taking four aspirins a day the answer is also yes. It is quite safe so long as the person taking the aspirin is able to tolerate them with no side effects.

If you would like to do more reading on the subject, Dr. Cattler has written and published several journal articles on his research. They can be found at medical libraries in the February 1981 issue of *Lancet*, the May 1981 issue of

International Ophthalmology and the July 1981 issue of the Canadian Journal of Ophthalmology.

Also, if you would like an overview of some studies, they have been written up in the *Journal of the American Medical Association*, December 1980 issue.

Dear Jo:

About incontinence — can you suggest a way to live with it?

Dear H.E.:

Incontinence is the inability to have control over bladder or bowel functions. It is a common problem among older persons.

Before accepting and learning to live with the problem, it is essential that you explore every means of help available so that you can regain this bodily function. You should consult your doctor or a urologist (a doctor who specializes in problems in this area) to have a complete physical examination.

If your problem persists and you are in need of specific suggestions on how to deal with your individual incontinent needs, I suggest you contact a public health nurse in your community for her specialized assistance.

Dear Jo:

I found an excellent book for my mother age 84 who lives alone in her own home. It is called "An Easier Way: Handbook for the Elderly and Handicapped," written by Fean Vleis Sargent, and published by the Iowa State University Press in Ames, Iowa. The book has countless helpful hints for persons such as my mother, as well as suggestions on the use of special equipment and other devices.

Volunteer Bureau in Birmingham. And if you enjoy meeting and talking with people you could help the bureau by interviewing prospective volunteers to match skills with different community agency requirements.

• MEDIATORS — If you have a college degree or a background in consumer affairs, this may be the position for you. The Channel 2 television station in Southfield needs volunteers to act as mediators for viewers who call the station with consumer problems. Volunteers will receive on-the-job training and are requested to make a one- or two-day weekly commitment for one year.
