That probe, released this week, said Israel's Defense Minister Ariel Sharon must bear "personal responsibility" in the massacre at Sabra and Chatilla Palestinian camps in Lebanon last September. Hundreds of Palestinians were killed by Lebanese Christian Phalangists as Israeli troops stood by.

"Israel is the only friend in the Middle East with true credibility," said Jackson.

Linowitz, President Carter's special representative to the Israeli-Egyptian negotiations, was even more emphatic.

"The only avenue to resolve the Palestinian situation is the Camp David agreement and without U.S. leadership, there won't be peace," he said.

Although generally supportive of Israel, Linowitz criticized that government for recent actions which he believes retarded the moves toward peace.

He cited the removal by the Israeli

government of Palestinian mayors on the West Bank and the continued building of Israeli settlements in that area.

Including the Palestinians in negotiations is a necessity if peace is to be obtained, he said.

Both Jackson and Sisco warned that the region risks an increased Soviet involvement if the United States is reluctant to continue its full commitment to Israel.

Jackson said the Soviets are installing new highly sophisticated surface-to-air missiles in Syria which before now have never been deployed outside

of the Soviet Union.

"They have a range...which covers a substantial part of Israel, the eastern Mediterranean and southern Turkey," said Jackson.

He also said that some 200 Soviet technicians are in Syria to man those missiles.

But Sisco held out some note of hope concerning Soviet involvement in the Middle East.

"The Arabs have learned that the Soviets can only help in making war, but the U.S. is the only one which can help make peace," he said.
