'Petrushka' rendition would be hard to top By Avigdor Zeromp special writer

The name of the Detroit Symphony Orchestra's most recent guest conduc-tor is familiar to many listeners. This isn't just because his grandfa-ther, Ernst von Dohnanyi, was a lead-ing and internationally acclaimed Hun-

garian composer. Christoph von Dohna-nyi is by now a recognized conductor world wide in his own right.

This reputation has been recently reaffirmed by his appointment as mu-sic director of the Cleveland Symphony Orchestra, starting in the 1984:55 sec-son, which proves that at least at one place the ornifous year "1984" is not going to be a total disaster.

IN HIS DEBUT here, Dohnanyi demonstrated his musical versaillity by proving to be equally adopt with composers as diverse as Mozarit and Stravinsky. The two Mozart composi-tions on the program were the Sympho-ny No. 24 for Plano and Orchestra In C minor, K. 491.

The second portion of the program consisted of a single work — Stravin-sky's music to the ballet "Petrustka." Guest plantst was the young, gilted and German-born Gerhard Oppitz.

The Symphony No. 25, in spite of its advanced numerical designation comadvances numerical designation com-pared to most other composers, was written when Mozart was only 17. This young age, however, isn't reflected in its mature and profound outline. This is Mozart's carliest symphony that is part of the familier repetoire — most of the carlier ones are almost page performed (other

My only issue with this performance was his disposition to strike the grace-notes in the minuet absurgly rand before the beat. There is ample evidence to suggest that such notes were customar-ingue and early posit-barouge periods, with a longer duration, which seems to be more appropriate. But this is doomed to be one of those unresolved issues.

THE PIANO CONCERTO No. 24, which is the only one among Mozart's 27 concerti which is in the common key of C minor, is regarded by many as among his best, possibly his very best. Unlike many compositions for a solo instrument, this composition gives the plano and orchestra almost equal roles, a feature that has been duly recognized by planist Oppliz.

One can seldom hear a presentation of "Petrushia" which is as satifying as this one. Like some of Stavinaxy's other scores, this music is very com-plex, written for a large orchestra, with assorted instruments. But with Dohnany in complete command, no single nois was wasted.

The beauty of the music was mani-fested in all its rich and colorful sounds. The numerous solo instrumen-tal passages were superbly played by the individual players, without excep-tion.

All the instrumental sections were perfectly coordinated and integrated, resulting in scenes that were so clear and vivid, almost as if they were actuand vivid, almost as if they were actu-ally performed on the stage. This doesn't suggest however, that the actu-al ballet performance is redundant.
