A TASTE of New Orleans will kick off a series of American regional dinners, prepared by chef Kevin Enright of the Double Eagle, 5725 Rochester and Square Lake roads, Troy.

The eight-course dinner featuring an "All-American bill of fare" will be served at 6:30 p.m., Tuesday. For reservations at \$25 per person call the restaurant at 879-1555.

Fine herb gumbo and dandelion greens salad will lead up to a fish course of crawfish and crab with an American whiskey veloute. Then there's a break for refresher of cranberry zinfandel ice, preceding the main dish of chicken rochambeau with two sauces.

A fresh fruit and cheese course, plus pecan chocolate flan complete the lavish meal. American champagne and California wine will be served.

A portion of the proceeds will go to a chef's apprentice program.

RENOVATION of the Hotel St. Regis in Detroit's New Center area has brought changes in size to the restaurant and lounge.

The restaurant has been made smaller, it's reported, "in the tradition of a small European hotel," while the lounge has been doubled in size, for multi-purpose use.

Guests may enjoy their dinner while seated in the lounge, then have the first course served in the restaurant. Cordon bleu-trained chef Jan Emous offers a French and Continental menu.
