ECENT STOCK MARKET patterns have helped revive interest in various investments. Here is a selected reading list on investment.

- GOOD GENERAL READING

 * "Extraordinary Popular Delusions and the Madness of Crowds" by Charles Mackay, published in 1841 and reprinted by Harmony Books. A history of the crazes that have select great masses of people. Financier Bernard Baruch said that this book saved him millions before the Crasb of 1929.

 * "Winning With Money" by Beryl W. Sprinkel and Robert J. Genetski, Dow Jones-Irwin. How to put yourself on the winning side of economic policies. Sprinkel is an undersecretary of the Treasury; his explanation of government monetary policy alone makes the book worth reading.

 * "Where are the Customers' Yachta?" by Fred Schwed Jr., Simon & Schuster. A fun book illustrated by Peter Arno that debunks all of the above.

- "Inside Wall Street" by Sid Mittra, Dow Jones-Irwin. The book provides a good introduction to investing in the stock market.
