

Games, workshops at Cranbrook Center offers 8-day science program

Prognod the mystery guest and his robot friends, plus snakes, frogs and a shadow wall will mingle with educational programs during an eight-day "Up With Science" adventure April 2 through 10 at Cranbrook Institute of Science, 500 Lone Pine, Bloomfield Hills.

Aimed at raising the public's scientific IQ through fun, games and hands-on experiences, along with lectures, demonstrations and workshops, the institute's second annual scientific odyssey will feature glimpses into fields ranging from robotics to reptiles.

Starting will be a seven-and-one-half-foot tall computer-driven sculpture complete with radar, a microphone and photocell. Called Prognod, the piece can sense, hear and see objects, then respond with abstract patterns on its screen.

Also featured will be a mobile, programmable robot named Hero I, which works with arm, grippers, voice and sensors, plus a display of computers with voice programs.

THROUGH DEMONSTRATIONS moderated by professionals from industry and academic research facilities — all members of the American Association for the Advancement of Science — visitors can explore such topics as phobias, human cancer cells, silver, infrared imagery and the relationship between brain and behavior.

In addition, chemistry, computer programming, orienteering, mousetrap boat, kite and various other workshops can open new vistas for both adults and children.

Among exhibits for viewing will be air recreational vehicles called ultralights (with demonstrations, weather permitting) and science projects from the Science and Engineering Fair of Metropolitan Detroit. Available for operating will be vehicle components with disc brakes, locking differential and viscous fan drive features.

ALONG WITH regular Cranbrook Institute of Science events — planetarium shows entitled "Cosmos," laser/light concerts, observatory demonstra-

tions and special exhibitions — "Up With Science" will include science magic, a shadow wall, Petroglyph rubbings, volcanic action, science puzzles, games and gadgets and puppet shows focusing on the problems of blindness.

Hours are daily 1-5 p.m. Regular museum hours are Monday-Friday 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. In addition to Friday evenings 7-10 p.m.; Saturdays 10 a.m. to 10 p.m.; and Sundays 1-5 p.m.

Except for some workshops and the laser/light show, "Up With Science" is included in regular admission of \$2.75 for adults; \$1.75 for students and senior citizens; and free for children under five.

Consultants awarded

For the third time in the past four years, the Farmington Hills firm of Meyer, Tiseo & Hinds Ltd. has received the Eminent Conceptor Award from the Consulting Engineers Council of Michigan.

This year's award was for the firm's design of a cofferdam 100 feet in diameter and 65 feet deep. Their design cut construction time in half and reduced construction cost by 25 percent. The cofferdam was installed to permit construction of a new water intake structure and pump station in Lake County, Ohio, just east of Cleveland.

The council annually selects one firm to receive the Eminent Conceptor Award. In previous years, Meyer, Tiseo & Hinds Ltd. has received this honor for their work on the Sterling Heights Emergency Sewer Repair (1981) and the design of a hazardous waste disposal facility in Monroe County (1980).
