## NOTICE TO CUT WEEDS

It shall be the duty of all owners of any subdivided land in any subdivision located within the boundaries of the City of Farmington Hills to destroy any noxious weeds growing on said property before they reach a seed bearing stage so as to prevent them from becoming a detriment to public health. Any weeds not cut by June 1, 1983, will be cut by the City, and the owner of the property charged with the cost under provisions of the Farmington Hills City Code, Chapter 41, Section 41.120. This will be done as many times as necessary during the growing season. In addition any owner who shall refuse to destroy such noxious weeds as provided for in this City Code shall be subject to a fine of not more than \$100.00. Noxious weeds are those described in Section 2 of Act 359 of the Public Acts of 1941, as amended, and all other weeds, wild grasses and plants, the uncontrolled growth of which would constitute a nuisance.

### CITY OF FARMINGTON HILLS SUMMARY OF PROCEEDINGS REGULAR PUBLIC HEARING March 21, 1983

Mayor Hughes opened the regular Public Hearing of the City Council of the City of Farmington Hills on March 21, 1983, at 7:30 p.m. Members present were: Burwell, Dolan, Hughes, Lange, Soronen, Williams and Wolf. Others present: Assistant City Manager Costick, City Clerk Cairns, City Attorney Poehlman and City Planner Coates.

Council introduced Zoning Map Amendment C62-293 (ZR 16-13-82) to rezone a parcel of land on south side of Twelve Mile Road, east of Haledale Road from RA-1 to OS-1. Zoning Map Amendment C62-294 was introduced (ZR 1-1-83) to rezone 8.75 acres on the southeast corner of Nine Mile and Tuck Road from B-3 to RC-2.

Council approved Resolution No. 5, adopting special assessment roll for road improvement for Oxford Street, SAD No. 170.

Council approved Resolution No. 5, adopting special assessment roll for road improvement for Hugo, Parker and Tillman, SAD No. 171.

Council approved Resolution No. 3, to proceed with road improvements for Hugo Street from Tillman to Junction. Resolution No. 4 also approved, setting the Public Hearing for April 18, 1983.

Vacation (V-1-1983) of part of an easement between Lots 7 and 8 of Thompson Brown Office Center in Section 15 was approved.

Vacation (V-3-1983) of Roadway at Ten Mile Road and Grand River intersection, that part of Grand River right-of-way lying south of Lots 1 and 2 Supervisor's Plat No. 11 in Section 19 was approved subject to provision for a sidewalk, easement for maintenance of utilities and for future installation of the extension of the Caddell Drain and that there be no exterior lighting in the vacated area.

Vacation (V-3-1983) of a portion of Westfield Drive from 13 Mile Road, north to the center of Lot 179 of Oakland Subdivision in Section 3 be adjourned until April 11, 1983.

Council enacted Amending Ordinance C-83, Amendment to the Uniform Traffic Code.

Council approved introduction of Ordinance conveying ¼ acre of land held by the City adjacent to 7496 and Middlebelt Road to Northstar Associates.

Resolution was adopted regarding appointment of Regional Administration Board for Detroit sewer and water system.

Council granted residents on Moran Street to opt out of City's Dust Control Program. A meeting with City of Farmington to review jointly funded budget was set for April 6, 1983 at 7:00 P.M. in the City of Farmington Hills Council Chambers.

Council accepted the budget request of the Historical Commission for rehabilitation of West Farmington Cemetery Sign.

Community Development Block Grant Program Application was reviewed and Council set Public Hearing for April 11, 1983, at 7:30 P.M. on proper use of Community Development Block Grant funds for 1983-84.

Council requested staff to submit report for the projected cost and proposed use of the Spicer property.

Meeting adjourned at 10:10 p.m.
