Health-O-Rama offers 'best bargain in town'

Health-O-Rama, the free health screening tests sponsored by WXYZ-TV, ABC in Detroit, Blue Cross-Blue Shield of Michigan and United Health Organization, will be offered at 85 sites in seven counties on various dates in April to anyone 18 or older.

Billed as "the best bargain in town," participants can obtain from \$75-\$150 worth of health tests designed to detect disease in its first stages of development for the prevention of serious illness.

The only exception to the free tests is the optional blood test panel of 21 tests, which will cost \$7.

Farmington and Farmington Hills residents who visit Health-O-Rama from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Wednesday, April 13, in Mercy Center can take two additional tests not offered in this area before.

Through the efforts of the Farmington Area Commission on Aging, hearing tests are offered in cooperation

from Henry Ford Bloomfield Hills and glaucoma tests are offered from Detroit Optometric Center.

All Project Health-O-Rama sites will offer height and weight tests, blood pressure, vision tests, health hazard appraisals, health history, counseling, referrals and the blood panel.

The screenings search for high blood pressure, diabetes, liver disease, sight loss, cancer, kidney disease, gout and other conditions.

Most sites will offer exhibits and materials on health problems and disease to help make sound decisions about health.
