Easter Bunny arriving at brunch

EASTER BRUNCH will be served from 8 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. Sunday in the ballroom of the Troy Hilton Inn. The Easter Bunny will pass out jelly beans, a live bunny farm will be displayed, and free photos will be taken with the Easter Bunny. Prices are \$7.25 for adults, \$5.75 for senior citizens and children under 12. For reservations, call 583-9000. The Haymarket will have an Easter menu 2:30-6 p.m.

Baked Virginia ham, roast leg of lamb and prime rib of beef are among Chef Lindner's special offerings at dinner. Other entrees will include seafood and fresh Dover sole, as usual. A SUNDAY Champagne Brunch regularly is featured at Restaurant Duglass in Southfield. Ballroom dancing, with music by the George Primo Trio, is the attraction from noon to 3 p.m. Sunday. Primo also entertains solo at the piano every night at the restaurant.

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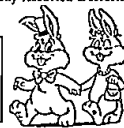
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Dear Sadie,
