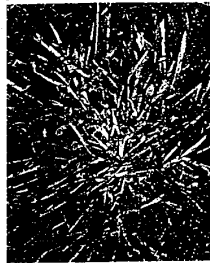

BOB BRIGGS, working in relief of Daryl Demaree, was the winning pitcher for Glenn against Franklin.

Briggs knocked in a run in the first inning while Bob Newsome and Demaree singled in runs in the second.

Two hits and two walks led to another pair of Glenn runs in the fourth. Then came three runs in the fifth without the benefit of a hit and a final run in the sixth.

Franklin's big inning was the fifth when hits by Don Opland, Bob Grills, Frank Kasperek and Rob Hollandsworth, along with a couple walks, led to a five-run uprising.
