## Cancer foundation calls volunteers

The Cancer Information Service, housed in Michigan Cancer Foundation (MCF), is recruiting volunteers to become Information Specialists for the toll-free telephone information and referral system. The training schedule will be six sessions of four hours each, April 19 through April 28.

Potential trainees do not need prior knowledge of cancer, although it is helpful. Throughout the training, the volunteers will acquire a number of useful skills.

"They will learn cancer medical knowledge, research trends, interpersonal communication skills, as well as referral techniques for community resources and services," said Jane Hoy, coordinator of the program.

The Cancer Information Service is

part of a national network of cancer information centers funded by the National Cancer Institute (NCI). The phone lines, accessible to all Michigan residents, are open 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. weekdays. The volunteers provide accurate cancer information and assistance to the lay public and health professionals.

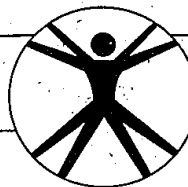

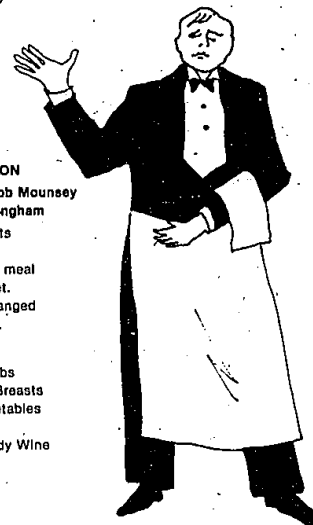

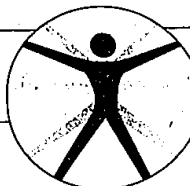
