The June 13 school board race in the Clarenceville School District will be unopposed this year, barring any write-in candidates.

As of Monday's filing deadline, only the two incumbents filed petitions to appear on the June ballot.

Samuel Prisk, a board member for the past 23 years, is running for re-election along with trustee Barry Sherman, who's completing his fifth year on the board.

The district, which takes in parts of Livonia, Redford Township and Farmington Hills, has two four-year posts available this year.

Both trustees are Livonia residents. Prisk, 60, is a self-employed dentist who works in Redford Township. He has been active in numerous scouting activities for the past 43 years. He has three grown children who are graduates of Clarenceville High School.

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Students compete in mind olympics

Farmington public school students will be participating in "Olympics of the Mind" from 1-5 p.m. April 23 at the Farmington Training Center, 33000 Thomas, Farmington. The public is invited.

The "Olympics of the Mind" program is a team competition in creative problem solving. It was established in 1976 by Dr. Sam Micklus, a teacher of industrial design at Glassboro State College, New Jersey, and Dr. Theodore J. Gouley, New Jersey Director of Gift-

ed and Talented Education. The program was sponsored by the Lipper Foundation and has grown to include schools from around the country.

The "Olympics of the Mind" culminates in a World Competition each spring. Long-term and spontaneous problems are presented to a team of five students who are coached by an adult.

Last year, 10 Farmington teams competed in the state competition.

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
