parenting, Family and Children Servicess of Oakland is offering a Parent
Enrichment group beginning May 16.

The six-session series runs 7:30-930
p.m. in Jewish Community Center in
West Bloomfield. The series will ex-

piore the behavior of children from newborns to 5-year-olds. It will examine their stages of development, physical and social capabilities and how parents can stimulate their children's growth and enhance their own lives. Child care is provided free, and the cost of the series is based on a silding scale, with \$55 at the top. For registration information, call \$44-044.

"We don't want anyone to miss out on the program on the basis of money," social worker Ronal Tischlersaid.

"There are usually six couples in each group, and we discuss parents' concerns about spoiling a child, toilet

training, discipline and child-proofing a house," she added.

FAMILY and Children Services of Oakland is a private, nonprofit counseling agency serving all persons who live or work in Oakland County. The agency offers continual classes on all types of family counseling, including alcohol and spouse abuse, aging, single parenting, unemployment counseling and perinatal coaching for early parenting skills.

It is funded by the United Way of Pontiac-North Oakland and the United

Foundation of Metropolitan Detroit Tischler said.

The agency has branches in Pontiac,
Berkley, Walled Lake and Southfield.
Persons may go to the most convenient
location for individual counseling ser-

vices.

Bill Frye, the agency's executive director, said they serve 8,000 people annually and operated with a \$1,8 million budget in 1982.

All of the counseling sessions are led by social workers with master's degrees, Tischier said, and they have all had experience working with family problems.
