Cottler does his best to dispell old age myths

THIS TIME, OTHER composers lso were featured. The only non-Rusian composition was the Second Piano foncerto, in F Minor, by Chopin. The plasist in the Chopin Concerto as Mischa Kottler, who has been a rominent talent in the Detroit commity for many years. His performnce underscored the fact that musical

Kottler, who has reached his 80th itribday, provides one of the strongest asses against those who have the misuided notion that one should retire after reaching a certain age.

HIS PERFORMANCE of the Chopin HIS PERFORMANCE of the Chopin concerto was not just an adequate per-ormance for an 80-year-old. It was a refound statement and testament for II ages. Kottler's playing was charac-erized by both brilliancy and deep, re-factive insight. He had a complete technical com-tand most of the time, even though dere were some isolated flawed notes, the most serious occasion being in the bild movement. before the cost

THE ONE WEAK point in this composition is Chopia's own delicient orchestration. While some performances provide a better cover-up of this deficiency than this one, there is no way to redeem it completely, as far as the orchestral aspect is concerned.

It is best appreciated for what it is a magnificent composition highlighting the plano, the only important instrument in Chopia's works. Following a rousing, standing ovation, Kottler obliged by playing as an encore a Rachmanhoff arrangement of a theme by Kreisler.

Maestro Shostakovich wasn't outdone when it was his turn to shine. He opened the program with the Prelude to Khovansichina by Mussorgaky, a short piece which brought for the tender, reflective aide of this composer.

THE CONCLUDING WORK on the program was the Symphony No. 1 by Shostakovich, which was the most extensive orchestral work on the program. The first of the 15 symphonies by the composer, it is a profound and mature piece, composed when he was only 18.

Maestro Shostakovich captured superbly the many contradictory moods of that composition. Like several of the composer's other works, it complines playful and satirical elements with tender, expressive and melancholic themes, as well as some gushing and turbulent segments.

The coda in the last movement is preceded by an unusual timpant solo. The energetic and spirited performance of this work deserves the highest acclaim.

To be sure, not everybody is in complete agreement as to the ability of Mastro Shostakovich as a conductor. Some musiclans criticize his batton technique, and I am not sufficiently competent to higher on the matter. But those who feel that he is merely an exponent of his father's music are seriously underestimating him.

While so far this was the major ingredient of his programs here, there is no doubt in my mind that his taient is much more universal.

ANYBODY WHO CAN present so impressively the Shostakovich compositions we've heard so far, no matter what baton technique he uses, abould do well with aimost any major composer. This week there will be a chance to prove this assertion, when Meestro Shostakovich will conduct works by Debussy, Franck (Symphonic Variations) and Berlior (Symphonic Pantastique). Hopefolly, those who had reservations about his ability will be eating their own words. As for me, I am a very fussy eater. sy enter.


