

Birthday gifts for a city

NEARLY 70 LOCAL BUSINESS-ES and corporations responded to the city's request for contributions to the Southfield 25th Anniversary Fund by giving over \$11,000. This money will be used to fund the city's anniversary celebration, including a major fireworks display scheduled for Thursday, April 28, and the creation of a commemorative sculpture for the Civic Center Plaza honoring the 1,400 volunteers who have served on city boards and commissions in the past 25 years.
