Here's a sampling of milestones for some of Southfield's private institutions:

WAYNE STATE — The university transformed barracks into classrooms nearly 20 years ago at a former Nike missile base on 11 Mile. One of five WSU extension centers, the campus was expanded in 1978 to include the former Anglin Road Elementary School on Franklin Road. Three years later the building was sold to Continental Cable and the 11 Mile site became WSU's only Southfield campus.

LIT — Lawrence Institute of Technology, with 5,868 students, is one of the largest private colleges in Michigan. Founded by Russell Lawrence, dean of the University of Detroit Engineering School, the college grew from rented classroom space in 1932 to an 85-acre campus on 10 Mile west of Evergreen. During the past 20 years the college developed a school of architecture. (1962) constructed a science building and established an arts and sciences school (1967) and opened a new administrative building. (1982).

OCC — Oakland Community College opened a \$6.4-million campus in October 1980 at Rutland south of Nine Mile. Part of the southeast system, which includes the Royal Oak and Oak Park campuses, the Southfield building was

constructed partially underground.

FRANCISCAN CENTER — Dun Scotus, run by Franciscan monks, was built at Evergreen and Nine Mile in 1930. Today it serves as a "formation center" offering theology classes for men interested in becoming Franciscan monks. Dun Scotus stopped offering a full college curriculum in 1979 because of enrollment decline and staff cuts.

BILINGUAL — Lycee International, a French bilingual school for preschool-eighth grade, opened in the former Evergreen Elementary School at 13 Mile and Evergreen two years ago. It also runs a night school for the fine arts and the Actors Alliance Theatre Co.

The Alex Manoogian School, started with 10 kindergartners in 1969 and expanded to include elementary-high school grades by 1977, with emphasis on Armenian culture.

CATHOLIC SCHOOLS — Since opening its doors in 1957, St. Bede's initiated a school board, built a 10-classroom addition and established an office of religious education. St. Michael's added a new wing to its school in 1966, and initiated a kindergarten in 1974.

SOUTHFIELD CHRISTIAN — Founded by Highland Park Baptist Church, Southfield, 13 years ago, the school graduated its first senior class in 1975. Two years ago it entered "the computer age" with the addition of six micro computers at its high school.
