Beleaguered I-696

It's down to the wire for highway

Freeway fighters from Lathrup Village and Pleasant Ridge are readying for another battle to try to block construction of the missing link of 1-696. Federal Court Judge Anna Diggs-Taylor set May 17 to hear arguments for a temporary restraining order against construction of the final eight-mile stretch of the proposed expressway through southern Oakland County. But the main legal battle will be June 17 when the two communities and a cilitzens group present arguments for a preliminary injunction. Construction of 1-696, which would generally follow 10 Mile and 11 Mile between Telegraph and 1-75, is scheduled to begin in June. Much of the land and many buildings along the right-of-way have already been cleared.

an organization called COUPON (Community Organization United to Preserve our Neighborhoods).

The group has proposed videning the east-west mile roads and installing north-bouth overpasses as an alternative to 1-698. Representives of the two communities say they fear the freeway will split their cities.

COST OF the six-year project is esti-mated at \$306 million. Southfield, which favors the proposed freeway route, will pay \$1.78 million as its share of the construction cost. The first construction in Southfield, between Labser and Santa Barbara, is

between Labser and Sania Barbara, is tentatively scheduled for the second half of 1984, according to Paul E. Ter-rain, 1-895 coordinator. Each segment should take approxi-mately three years to complete, Ter-rain said. The earliest final completion of the entire freeway is projected for 1989.

When the last section is completed, the freeway will extend 28 miles through the northern suburbs of the Detroit metropolitan area, connecting I-94 with I-96.

Within Southfield, the freeway will be along the 11 Mile corridor from west of Lahser east to Lexington Parkway (cast of Southfield Road). The expressway will proceed southeast to Greenfield at Goldwin.

Throughout its entire length, the freeway will run below ground level and will have approximately 20-foot high vertical concrete retaining walls to minimize the width of the right-of-way, Terrain said.

to minimize the width of the right-of-way, Terrain said. East of Greenfield, the freeway runs along the 10 Mile corridor to the exist-ing 1-75 freeway.

THERE WILL be three freeway lanes in each direction from Lahser to Southfield Road and four lanes each way from Southfield to I-75. Full-width

shoulders will be provided on each side of the traveled pavement.

Two-lane service drives at grade level on both aides of the freeway will widen to 3-4 lanes at off rampe and to 4-5 lanes at major intersections. Limited access ramps will allow entrance and exit to major intersections at Lahser, Evergreen and Central Park Blvd., Southfield Road and Greenfield.

Eleven bridges will handle South-field's through traffic at Labser, Lois Lane, east of Lois Lane, Central Park Blvd., Evergreen, Santa Barbara, Southfield Road, Lathrup Blvd., Coral Gables, Lincoln and 11 Mile at Green-

field.
Seven bridges for crossover traffic will be located west of Harvard, west of Evergreen, east of Evergreen, east of Santa Barbara, west of Southfield Road, east of Southfield Road and west of Greenfield.


