Roop changes pace

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But, like all aspiring athletes, he dreams of playing on the pro level. And like his style of kickboxing, Roop says he's the type of racketball player people would come to see.

"I believe I can be as successful playing racketball as I am at kickboxing," Roop said. "I find the way I play right now is exciting to watch. What I do to get a ball or get a point — I dive, jump and fly. What I do to return is amazing to me. I think I'm exciting to watch."

If Roop does decide to compete on a professional level, his best bet is likely to be in the senior division, which starts at age 35. It's unlikely age will catch up to the active Roop, either. He modestly says he's in as good shape as most 22-year-olds.

"I compete in the senior division. I'll probably be one of the top players," Roop said. "I won't be in any worse shape than I am now, that's for sure."

IT COULD BE said — in the field of athletics — that Roop is making up for lost time. As a student at St. Clair Shores South Lake, Roop did not participate in athletics. Since his father died when Roop was a child, he said he had to work during his high school years to help support the family.

Roop married at the age of 17 and again didn't have time for athletics — just work.

"I was always working and managing restaurants," Roop said. "I never had sports to play. When I finally started kickboxing at age 23, I went crazy. I don't know what would have happened if I'd have participated in sports in high school. I probably would have been a Billy Sims or something."

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Hawk girls edge Raiders Track relays ready

North boys continue winning ways

North Farmington's girls' and boys' track teams have dominated the annual city meet over the past few seasons. Things were a little different this year.

The Raiders' boys' team made it five victories over the past six years (Farmington High won in 1981). But it didn't come easy. North had 76 points, while Farmington was close behind with 65 and Harrison was third with 22.

In the girls' meet, Harrison High School won by one point over three-time defending champion North Farmington. The Hawks, whose last city girls' track title was in 1979, compiled 55 points, while the Raiders had 54 and Farmington was a close third with 47.

In the boys' meet, Farmington dominated the field events as Pete Brown won both the shot put (53 feet, 8 inches) and discus (148 feet) and Falcon teammate John Clappison took the high jump (6 feet). The long jump winner was North's Eric Collier and the pole vault champ was Harrison's Dave Dixon.

Farmington also took two of the three relay events.

The Falcons won both the 800- (Mike Forge, Brian Looser, Jim Simmons and Paul Polus) and 400-meter (Forge, Mike Ryan, Simmons and Polus) relays with times of 1:33.9 and 45.8, respectively.

North Farmington's winning 1,600-meter relay team included Kevin Weine, Eric Zuckerman, Rob Griffin and Collier. Their time was 3:35.7.

North's Rob Griffin took the 110-meter high hurdles in 15.5 while teammate Bob Loeffler won the 300-meter low hurdles in 40.6. Raider Chris Walker won the distance races, taking the 1,600 in a time of 4:39.4 and the 3,200 in 10:19.9.

Harrison's Mike Rosenau won the 100-meter dash in 11.4 and North's Dan Schaffer took the 200-meter dash in 23.85. Collier won the 400-meter run (52.2) and Zuckerman won the 800-meter run (2:02.7).
