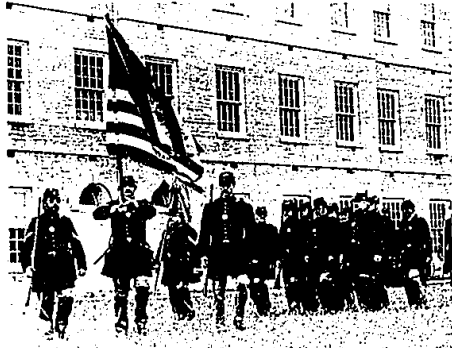
Regiments to re-enact Civil War
