

La Cuisine chef comes to the center

The Farmington Community Center will present an evening for cooks, from the beginner to the gourmet. At 7:30 p.m. Monday Francois Sully, owner of La Cuisine in Windsor, will demonstrate several of his favorite dishes. Those attending will have the chance to sample the chef's work.

The demonstration will begin with a duck terrine, followed by filet of beef in a wine, oil and vinegar marinade and served venison-style.

Sully has chosen gratin provencal,

which combines the flavors of tomatoes, zucchini and eggplant in a rich casserole to accompany the entree. Dessert will be poached pears in red wine.

Included in the program will be taste samples of the array of dishes demonstrated. And Sully will tell humorous anecdotes of his early life in France, and later in Canada.

Born in Paris in 1942, the cook followed his family's love for the stage and was an actor until he left for Canada in 1967. On his own in Canada, he explored various job opportunities; then joined CBC radio as a producer.

Four years later the self-taught gourmet established La Cuisine as the first French restaurant in Windsor.

The family-run cafe has grown in popularity as he and his family continue to prepare and serve epicurean delights.

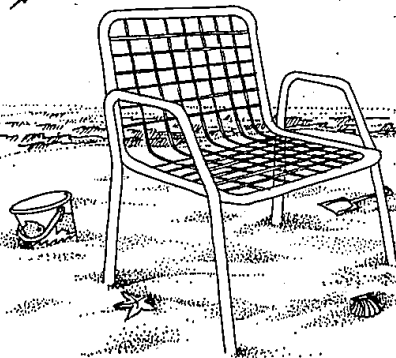

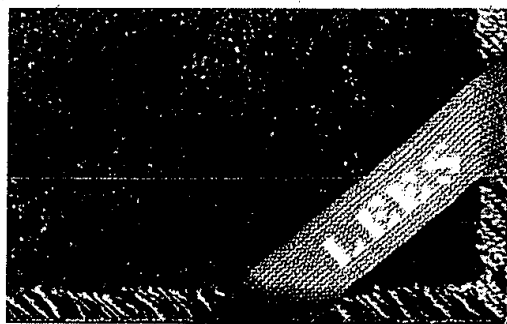
