Daylong festival features bluegrass

The Stroh's Motor City Bluegrass and Traditional Music Festival will be held at noon Sunday, May 29, at the Meadow Brook Music Festival site at Oakland University near Rochester. Now in its fourth year, the event is a fund-raiser for public radio station WDET in Detroit. Tickets are \$7 in advance and \$9 at the gate. Advance tickets are available at CTC outlets and at several locations including the Musical Oasis in Birmingham, Music Mill in Lake Orion, Dearborn Music in Dearborn, Gittfiddler's in Northville, Schoolkids Records in Ann Arbor and Elderly Instruments in Lansing.
