## Moral immaturity plagues our society

At the recently held Livonia Prayer Breakfast the Honorable Paul Hellyer, former vice prime minister of Canada, suggests that as we become technological giants we can remain moral adolescents.

Considering the motivation of much adolescent behavior, the man from across the border was right on target. While the adolescent population is not totally devoid of responsible persons, there are certain commonalities in their behavior motivation that leaves something to be desired.

For one thing, they are often short-sighted. They tend to look for quick solutions to immediate difficulties often ignoring long-term effects.

They are also prone to be self-centered to the exclusion of considering the effects of their behavior on others.

THIS IS why their stereo can be heard above most toronado. Gut reaction rather than rational analysis is often a motivating factor in the decisions they make. Finally, those who have not yet reached moral adulthood have a way of justifying practically anything they might do.

To suggest, however, that such behavior is limited to those in their teen years is unfair to many in this age group. At the same time, it becomes an unvarnished acquittal of those, who despite their years, prefer an existence of ethical acme.

Short-sightedness in problem solving is not limited to those on the bottom side of drinking age. Our technological decisions are ample indication. Pesticides, for example, are too often considered effective because they can kill bugs. But in too many cases the long-range effects have been left to someone else to deal with.

Nuclear reactors are accepted as an answer to energy problems. No matter that we have not yet found a safe way to dispose of the lethal waste. Someone can deal with that later.

ONE CONSTANT in our easy of living seems to be the amount of resources that go into picking up the pieces left from the solutions to yesterday's problems. Are we really that stupid or is Hellyer right. Are we simply too self-

ishly adolescent to care about the problems we create for those who come after us?

Self-centeredness is another trait which seems to survive adolescence. The "me-first" philosophy is alive and well across the widest generation gaps. Looking out for number one is taught by the advertisers and lived religiously by consumers. Such a mentality allows us to ignore the plight of the underpaid vegetable picker or the grounds that our salad is more important.

Meism also gives us permission to look at today's cost effectiveness for us as the bottom line of many of our decisions that affect others.

IT BECOMES the central consideration in the abortion of a life that threatens our convenience. When a "me-first" mentality is the driving force in the lives of individuals, they barely expect it to fade into the background when such individuals come together to make the decisions of business, education, government or the military.

Gut reaction also stands high on the list of motivators for much of society, regardless of age. For example, we do not choose to be distracted with the fact that capital punishment has little or no effect on serious crime.

Rather, we operate from a gut reaction for fear and revenge in order to fry the S.O.B. No matter that the system may have failed and given up the wrong man (Most executed people are male and lower class). At least they feel better and that makes it all right.

Yes, we do have a tendency to justify practically anything we want to do. We conduct wars in the name of good. We increase arms in the name of defense. We abort in the name of individual rights. We allow hunger and the systems which perpetuate it to continue in the name of letting others pull themselves up by their own boot straps.

Moral adolescence is alive and dealing in an age which prides itself on the ability to transplant the hearts of some while stopping the hearts of many and breaking the hearts of others. We all have a tendency to let us begin but apparently there is no age at which it automatically comes to an end.

I take great aspires a day for my arthritis, as prescribed by my doctor. The relief is marvelous, but I worry about some of the side effects, such as kidney damage, from taking so many in a day. Should I cut back on them or what?

Dear Mrs. C.:

According to a study done over a period of 10 years on 48 patients at the Massachusetts General Hospital Arthritis Clinic in Boston, there is no need for you to worry. The average dose of aspirin in those patients was 10 tablets a day, and their kidney function tests showed no damage. The study was reported in the Journal of the American Medical Association, Vol. 247. You may want to get a copy of the article for your own peace of mind.

As to whether or not you should ever

cut back on a prescribed medication, even aspirin, for arthritis, this decision should be made by your doctor.

Dear Jo:

I am on a low-cholesterol diet. I manage fine at home when I am in control of the preparation of my food, but eating out is a real problem. I enjoy traveling with my husband, but I find it too impossible to stay on this diet. Other than staying at home what would you suggest I do?

Dear Mrs. W.:

My advice to you is to make up your mind that you will stick to your diet, no matter what (or where). Obviously, you are managing very well at home. When eating out, know your restaurants, be aware of their specialties, and when in doubt about certain foods on the menu, inquire as to how they are prepared. When ordering, you can ask the waiter to substitute margarine for butter, and if it is not available, eat your bread or vegetable plain; ask that your entree be broiled or baked and hold all sauces and gravies. When your are served, trim the fat from the meat and/or remove the skin from the poultry. You should avoid all foods that are fried, particularly those that are fried in butter.

When traveling by car, you can bring along certain foods like fresh fruits and vegetables that can supplement your diet, and if you travel by air, you can request a low-cholesterol meal when you make your reservation. Good Luck.
