## Grollman to explore death and grief in talk

Earl Grollman, rabbi of Beth El Temple Center in Belmont, Mass., will speak on bereavement, death and grief during an all-day seminar Thursday, June 2, in St. Edith Church, 15089 Newburgh, Livonia. His appearance is sponsored by Hospice Support Service, a voluntary agency that helps the terminally ill die at home, located in Whittier School in Westland. The seminar offers the general public help in dealing with grief. It is also designed for lawyers, psychologists and members of other professions who have to deal with bereavement. Registration is at 12:30 p.m. Grollman will speak on grief and bereavement as a process at 1 p.m. At 2 p.m. he will explore grief and bereavement as it applies to hospices. At 7:30 p.m. his topic will be "Children and Death." Tickets are \$20 for three sessions, or \$7.50 for each individual session. A pioneer in the field of death and crisis intervention, Grollman is author of "Talking About Death," which received the Trends Citation at the International Children and Youth Book Exhibition in Munich. Some of his other books are "Suicide: Prevention, Intervention, Post-vention," "Explaining Divorce to Children" and "Explaining Death to Children." Grollman is a member of the Governor's Council on Action for Mental Health in Massachusetts and the Conjugal Bereavement Team of Harvard University Community School of Psychiatry.
